TANZANIA SAFARI & SOLARBUDDY

DAY ONE

Upon arrival into Tanzania you will be greeted by our team and taken to the Springlands Hotel in Moshi. Once you are settled in there will be a trip briefing and group dinner.

DAY TWO

After breakfast, drive from Springlands hotel to Lake Manyara National Park, which takes about 4 hours. After having a picnic lunch in Manyara, you start a late afternoon game drive, which is the best time to view animals in this park. When you approach it from the east, Rift Valley escarpment looms on the horizon forming an impressive backdrop to the lake. In the tall trees of the forest, monkeys leap from branch to branch, on the escarpment elephants stand in the shade. Other animals frequently seen are zebras, impalas, monkeys, giraffes, buffalos, hippos and others. Dinner and overnight at Highview Hotel.

DAY THREE

After breakfast, drive to Ngorongoro Crater for a half day game drive inside the crater. This is undoubtedly the best place to see black rhino in Tanzania as well as the pride of lions that includes the magnificent black mined males. There are lots of colorful flamingos and the variety of water birds. Other game that you may see includes leopard, cheetah, hyena, other members of the antelope family, and small mammals. Dinner and overnight at Highview Hotel.

DAY FOUR

Morning hike in the Southern Ngorongoro Conservation Area to the elephant cave and waterfall. In the afternoon visiting the Iraqw tribe cultural centre in Karatu to learn how the tribe protected their cattle from Maasai incursions using underground settlements. Dinner and overnight at Highview Hotel.

DAY FIVE

After breakfast, drive from the Highview Hotel to Tarangire National Park takes which takes 3 hours. Huge herds of wildebeest, zebras, elephants, elands, and Oryx gather to stay in Tarangire until the onset of the rain. Then, in the late evening drive back to the Springlands Hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY SIX

Today we make our way out to Chemke Springs. This 2 hour drive will give show a remote side of the Tanzanian plains before arriving at an incredible natural hot springs in the middle of the desert. This is a great place to swim and enjoy a relaxing day. Dinner and overnight at the Springlands Hotel.

DAY SEVEN

After breakfast, we head out to a local school to help deliver SolarBuddy solar lights. These lights help to improve education outcomes for people living in energy poverty. This full day brings us back to the Springlands hotel for a team dinner and our final night in Tanzania.

DAY EIGHT

You will be transferred to the airport for your international flight back to Australia after another unforgettable On Track Expedition.
